Target Return Date: 15 May, 15 June, 15 July, 15 August

Range: 50 Feet.

Position: Offhand.

Equipment: Fixed sight handguns only. Out of the box production, not from a manufacturer's custom shop. No alterations except the use of grips and sights that are offered as options for that specific gun by the manufacturer.

Barrel length is limited to 7.5" maximum.

Target: A-23/3 (1 record).

Course of fire: 4 min total for 5 shots on each of two record targets. Shooter must execute magazine change or revolver reload in the time allowed.

Classes: Revolver or Semi- Auto Handgun.

Fee: \$10.00 for each monthly entry; \$40.00 for each season entry.

Match 23: Season 200-Yard Black Powder Cartridge Rifle Silhouette Score

Target Return Date: 1 June, 1 July, 1 August, 1 September

Range: 200 Yards.

Position: Sitting or prone. Cross sticks allowed.

Equipment: Hunting or military style single-shot rifle originally made for use with black powder with plain base bullets. Rifle must have exposed hammer and weigh no more than 12lbs-2oz with iron sights or 15lbs with scope. No Schuetzen style rifles or stocks. Removable cheek pieces and recoil pads are permitted.

Sights: Iron sights or 6X scope with ext. adjustments, 3/4" max. dia.

Target: Turkey Silhouette.

Course of fire: 12 minutes for any sighters <u>before</u> 10 shots at target. Misses count towards shooter's 10 rounds. Full bullet hits counted only. Ties broken by most hits on white center dot or hit closest to white center dot.

Classes: Iron Sight or Scoped Rifle

Fee: \$10.00 for each monthly entry; \$40.00 for season entry.

Match 20: 200-Yard Military Benchrest Score

Target Return Date: 1 October

Range: 200 Yards.

Position: Benchrest.

Equipment: Military issued rifle. Front and rear rests must not be

connected.

Sights: Scope (Maximum of 6X) or Iron Sights.

Target: MR-52 (1 record and 1 sighter).

Course of fire: 10 shots in 20 minutes on record target.

Classes: Military Issue, Military Modified Iron, Military Modified Scope.

Fee: \$10.00 per entry.

Match 21: Antique Military Benchrest Group

Target Return Date: 15 November

Range: 100 Yards.

Position: Benchrest.

Equipment: Military rifle or carbine of any caliber issued by any nation corresponding with the definition of "antique firearm" as set forth in the Federal Firearms Regulations of the United States. Front and rear rests must not be connected. Military rifles/carbines originally designed for rimfire cartridges may be modified for centerfire.

Sights: Sights must be issue or strictly equivalent. (Example: Higher front sight or altered rear sight leaf so that firearm will shoot to point of aim at 100 yards).

Target: MR-31 (4 record and 1 sighter).

Course of Fire: 5 shots in 10 minutes on each record target.

Classes: Antique Military Rifle.

Fee: \$10.00 per entry.

GENERAL INFORMATION

How To Enter: Anyone desiring to enter postal match(es) should send a completed order form with appropriate fees, paid by check, to:

CBA Postal Match PO Box 33 Granite Falls, NC 28630

Please note that some matches require additional information such as the desired position and/or class that will be shot that needs to be included on the order form.

Reporting: Competitors will send the fired targets with the completed Technical Data Sheet to the appropriate scorer as listed on the Technical Data Sheet for the match that they are competing in. Returns must be postmarked no later than the specified Target Return Date. First-Class mailing is recommended. Please allow extra time for mailings from foreign countries.

Scoring: The scoring will be conducted by the Director of Postal Competitions or their designee. Please do not plug targets before mailing. **Awards:** Monetary awards will be mailed to the top three active CBA members in their respective class in the amounts of: \$15 for 1st place, \$10 for 2nd place, and \$5 for 3rd place. Match results and technical data will be published in *The Fouling Shot* and posted on the CBA website.

Entry Fees: The entry fee for each match is \$10. Entry fees must be paid by check, made out to "CBA Postal Match" in US funds. Please add additional funds for foreign orders at the current exchange rate. Multiple entries in a match are allowed only if multiple firearms are used; if scope and iron sights are used on the same firearm for different classes; if different cartridges are used in the same firearm if safe (Example: 38 Special in a gun chambered in 357 Magnum).

Sighter Targets: Targets sent together with the record targets for the use of the competitor to sight shots. You may shoot an unlimited number of sighter shots at any time during the course of fire of the match, subject to the rules of the match, while meeting the time requirements.

Bullets: Bullets must be cast of a lead alloy. They must be fixed in the neck of the centerfire cartridge case except for Match #13: Single-Shot Matches and in Unrestricted Rifle, Unrestricted Pistol, and Plain Base Rifle classes. Gas checks may be used except for Match #13: Single-Shot Matches and Plain Base Rifle class.

Sights: In all matches, iron sights will compete against iron sights, scope against scope, unless match is designated as an "any sight" match. Unless scope power is specifically limited in the individual match data, there are no maximum power limitations.

Conditions: All matches are to be fired during daylight hours on an outdoor range of the competitor's choice subject to yardage requirement of the match.

Positions: Benchrest is defined as fired from a bench with sandbag and/or conventional pedestal rest. Offhand is defined as fired from the standing position. Sling, palm-rest, hook buttplate, etc., may be used except in Match 12: Military Offhand and Match 18: Deer Hunter Practical. See individual match data for further information.

Targets Sent to You after Receiving Your Order:

CBA Official Group Target has 1 3/8" sighting square and 3/4" center circle. CBA Official Score Target has 5 record bulls and 1 sighter bull with 3/4" tenring.

TQ-4 (NRA 100-yd. Small-Bore Rifle Target) has a 2" ten-ring. Black sighting area is 8" in diameter. CBA Postal 100-Yard Military Target may be substituted.

MR-31 (NRA 100-Yard High Power Rifle Slow Fire Target) has a 1 3/4" ten-ring. Black sighting area is 5 3/4" in diameter. CBA Postal 100-Yard Military Target may be substituted.

Running Deer Target is a 28" X 42" brown paper target with scoring lines for values of hits. These lines are invisible at 100 yards.

MR-52 (NRA 200-Yard High Power Rifle Slow Fire Target) has a 3 3/4" ten-ring. Black sighting area is 11 3/4" in diameter.

A-23/3 (NRA 50 Yard Small Bore Three Bullseye Target) has a 7/8" ten-ring. Black sighting area is 3 7/8" in diameter.

Turkey Silhouette is a 19" x 25" white paper target with a classic turkey silhouette in black. Center white dot is 5/8" in diameter.

Target Return Date: 1 December

Range: 100 Yards. **Position:** Offhand.

Equipment: Any commercial hunting rifle, military sporter, or pistol with maximum weight with sights is 10.5 lbs. No artificial support allowed (sling,

palm rest, hook buttplate, etc.).

Sights: Scope (Maximum of 6X) or Iron Sights.

Target: Running Deer Target (1 record). Used targets can be supplied for

practice for a \$1.00/target additional charge.

Course of Fire: 10 shots in 10 minutes.

Classes: Hunting Rifle, Production Rifle, Hunter Pistol, and Long-Range

Pistol with sight clarification, I.E. iron sight or scope.

Fee: \$10.00 per entry.

Match 19: 200-Yard Combined Benchrest Group and Score

Target Return Date: 1 November

Range: 200 Yards. Position: Benchrest.

Equipment: See class rules for firearms. Separate front and rear rests required except for Unrestricted Rifle, Plain Base Rifle, and Plain Base Rifle

Sights: Scope only.

Target: CBA Score target (1record).

Course of Fire: 5 shot group on each record bull for a total of 25 shots in 45 minutes. Score will be by subtracting the total of the 5 groups from the score

(e.g., 225 - 1X minus 9.825" =215.175 - 1X).

Classes: Hunting Rifle, Production Rifle, Heavy Rifle, Unrestricted Rifle, Plain Base Rifle, Hunter Pistol, Long-Range Pistol, and Unrestricted Pistol.

Match 17: Lever/Pump/Break/Semi-Auto Action Benchrest Group and/or Score

Target Return Date: 15 October

Range: 100 Yards.

Position: Benchrest.

Equipment: Any factory-produced repeating lever action, pump action, break action, or semi-automatic rifle. Throating, bedding and/or free-floating is permitted. Trigger may be smoothed/lightened. Total weight with sights not to exceed 10.5 lbs. Separate front and rear rests required.

Sights: Scope or Iron Sights.

Target:

Group/Scope: CBA Group (4 record and 1 sighter).

Group/Iron: TQ-4 (4 record and 1 sighter). Score/Scope: CBA Score (1 record). Score/Iron: TQ-4 (1 record and 1 sighter).

Course of Fire:

For Group: 5 shots in 10 minutes on each record target.

For Score/Scope: 2 shots on each record bull. Total of 10 shots in 20 $\,$

CLASSES FOR CBA POSTAL MATCHES

Rifles

Hunting Rifle: Factory-produced rifle with original barrel, trigger, action, chamber and stock. Maximum weight with scope is 9.5 lbs. Rifles using an original issue military action that meet weight limit are allowed.

Production Rifle: Factory produced rifle with original barrel, trigger, action, chamber and stock. Maximum weight with scope is 12 lbs. Throating, bedding, and free-floating is permitted. Trigger may be smoothed / lightened. Rifles using an original issue military action and barrel that meet weight limit are allowed.

Heavy Rifle: Any rifle with sights weighing less than 14.0 lbs.

Unrestricted Rifle: Any rifle without restriction to its weight, stock configuration, or guidance means. Bullets need not be fixed in case.

Plain Base Rifle: Same as Unrestricted Rifle however bullet's base must be plain lead alloy without a gas check installed.

Military Issue Rifle: Military issued rifle of any nation. Rifle must be strictly as issued with no modifications.

Military Modified Iron Rifle: Military issued rifle of any nation. Rifle must have original receiver and issue barrel. Stock, trigger, and iron sights may be modified.

Military Modified Scope Rifle: Military issued rifle of any nation that is equipped with a maximum of 6X scope, as issued or aftermarket. Rifle must have original receiver and issue barrel. Stock and trigger may be modified.

Other Rifles: For matches 11, 14, 15, 16, 17, and 21, see the individual match descriptions for the definitions of allowable rifles.

Carbine: Military issued carbine of any nation as long as there is a corresponding long rifle manufactured and in use at the same time; or any military issue rifle with a barrel length of 21" or less. Carbines will be classed for matches the same as the corresponding military issue long rifles: Issue, Modified Iron, or Modified Scope except for Match 9: Military Carbine Benchrest in which only carbines are allowed.

Pistols

Hunter Pistol: Any pistol with weight not to exceed 4.0 lbs. with iron sights or 4.5 lbs. with scope unloaded. Trigger pull is not less than 2.0 lbs. Pistol barrel cannot be longer than 10.75" in length. Barrel/cylinder cannot be rebored or rechambered to accommodate a cartridge other than that for which it was originally manufactured.

Long-Range Pistol: Any pistol with a maximum weight of 7.0 lbs. with sights unloaded. Pistol barrel cannot be longer than 15" in length. This class will be divided into production pistol (factory produced with original barrel) and custom pistol.

Unrestricted Pistol: Any pistol with a pistol grip no longer than 6.5" in length measured from the rear of the trigger guard. Pistol barrel cannot be longer than 16" in length. Total pistol length cannot exceed 26".

Note: Defined match yardages will be reduced to 50 yards for all offhand matches for all pistol classes except Match 22: Season Timed Fire Pistol which is 50 feet. Competitors in Hunter Pistol class entering in a benchrest match will have the defined match yardage reduced to 50 yards except for Match 19: 200-Yard Combined Benchrest which will be reduced to 100 yards. Long-Range Pistol and Unrestricted Pistol competitors will compete at the match defined yardage.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Season Matches

The same firearm must be used in all sessions of a season match if the competitor is to be qualified for the aggregate award.

Technical Data Sheets

Technical Data Sheets will need to be legibly filled out and returned with your record targets to be scored. This information will be published in the results and viewable by anyone looking. Do not falsify this information as it may result in someone getting hurt.

Course of Fire: 5 shots in 10 minutes.

Classes: Hunter Rifle, Production Rifle, Heavy Rifle, Unrestricted Rifle, Plain Base Rifle, Hunter Pistol, Long-Range Pistol, and Unrestricted Pistol with

sight clarification, I.E. iron sight or scope.

Match 14: Single-Shot Match Group and/or Score

Equipment: Any single-shot rifle or pistol. The action must be manually operated and cartridge cases inserted into the chamber. Bullets must be plain base bullet consisting of cast lead alloy without gas checks. The bullet may be seated from the breech or muzzle. The bullet may be separately seated or fixed in cartridge case. Paper-patched bullets may be used. Bolt actions are not allowed. Front and rear rests must not be connected.
