One minute of angle
equals one inch at
100 yards.



INSTRUCTIONS:

For best results with 22 Long Rifle, high velocity ammunition, sight the rifle in initially at approximately 12-1/2 yards. (With the rifle properly sighted in at 12-1/2 yards, the bullet should hit the point of aim at 75 yards, be one inch above at 40 yards, and one inch low at 85 yards.)

With the SEARS Rifleman 4X scope, sight in the rifle while resting the fore-end on a rolled-up blanket. Sighting in on the exact center of the target, fire a three to five shot group at 12-1/2 yards. Use the center of the group as the average point of impact. (The grid marks on the target are 1/2 inch apart and represent 1/2 minute of angle at 100 yards or 4 minutes of angle at 12-1/2 yards. Therefore at 12-1/2 yards, the separation between grid marks represents 4 graduations on the SEARS Rifleman 4X scope at 12-1/2 yards or 1/2 graduation at 100 yards.)
